**A RESOLUTION OF SKY VALLEY, GEORGIA
APPROVAL OF THE RABUN COUNTY
JOINT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN - 2010**

WHEREAS, The Georgia Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Act of 1990 requires all local governments in Georgia to prepare or be included in a Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, Georgia's Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures for Solid Waste Management, as promulgated by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs, require local governments to update their Solid Waste Management Plan every ten years in order to remain in compliance with State law and be eligible to receive waste management grants, loans, and permits; and,

WHEREAS, A cooperative process has resulted in a Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan update for Rabun County and its municipalities of Clayton, Dillard, Mountain City, Sky Valley, Tallulah Falls and Tiger, including the required public hearings for development of the plan as required under Rules of the Department of Community Affairs, Minimum Standards and Procedures for Solid Waste Management;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Sky Valley hereby approves the update of the Rabun County Joint Solid Waste Management Plan, to submit to the Georgia Mountains Regional Commission and the Georgia Department of Community Affairs for review and approval prior to final adoption.

This resolution will become effective upon adoption by the City Council and approval by the Mayor as provided by the Charter of the City of Sky Valley.
